Unshakeable Faith

Genesis 22: 1-23

1. An **Unshakeable Faith** requires me to be obedient. Obedience is the foundation of an **Unshakeable Faith**.
By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. *Hebrews 11: 8*
After years of waiting (25 years), Abraham (100 years old) and Sarah (90 years old) finally had the son that God promised. In this account, God gives Abraham an amazing and extremely difficult assignment.

Discussion: How do you think you would respond to God's instruction to Abraham to offer up Isaac as a sacrifice?

Where do you sense God testing or challenging you in your life right now?

2. An **Unshakeable Faith** requires me to trust God.
Abraham reasoned that God could even raise the dead, and so in a manner of speaking he did receive Isaac back from death. *Hebrews 11: 19*
I must surrender control and trust God's plan, even when it doesn't make sense to me.

Discussion: Where do you get the strength to say YES to God when everything else inside of you says NO?

3. An **Unshakeable Faith** requires me to let God be God.
Isaac spoke up and said to his father Abraham, "Father?" "Yes, my son?" Abraham replied. "The fire and wood are here," Isaac said, "but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?" *Genesis 22: 7*
Abraham answered, "God himself will provide the lamb for the burnt offering, my son." And the two of them went on together. *Genesis 22: 8*

God provided a ram in the thicket for Abraham.

Discussion: Has God asked you to do something very difficult? Give a testimony of a time God has provided for you in a time of need.
