The Gospel

Mark 13: 32

Jesus is coming back soon. No one knows the day or the hour. The most important thing is that we are ready. We must understand the true Gospel.

Discussion: What does getting ready mean to you?

Genesis 2: 7

Adam and Eve were alive to God. They disobeyed God by eating of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

Genesis 2: 10

This resulted in spiritual death and eventually physical death. We have inherited Adam and Eve's sinful nature.

Romans 3: 23

Discussion: How do you define sin?

We were created for His glory.

Isaiah 43: 7

The carnal man can not bring glory to God

Jeremiah 17: 9

We need a heart change.

Discussion: How is God softening your heart lately?

In His mercy, God provided a solution for us to have a relationship with Him and bring Him glory.

Romans 5: 8

John 3:3

When we are born again, we are spiritually alive and we will live forever with God. We can give God glory and bless Him.

Discussion: Think of a specific disappointment you've faced recently—how might God be using that situation to draw you closer to Him or redirect your focus toward His glory?

The Gospel is simple. Jesus died and rose for our justification. He removes our sin and forgives.

Psalms 103: 12

We are saved by grace and grace alone, not of works.

Ephesians 2: 8-9

Once we are born again, He gives us work to do. We live our life in Him and live to bring Him glory. The Gospel starts everything. We have a new life, a new purpose, and a new heart.

Revelation 21: 5

Discussion: When have you felt spiritually dry or desperate, and how did turning to Jesus—the true Rock—bring refreshment or renewal to your faith?
