Why Did Jesus Come?

1. To seek and save the lost.

for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.” Luke 19: 10

Discussion: Where did Jesus find you?

2. Because God loves us and wants us to be with Him in eternity.

that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. John 3: 15-18

3. To serve and give His life as a ransom for many.

just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.” Matthew 20: 28

4. To destroy the works of the devil.

He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. 1

John 3: 8
